# E) Fee: -

Apart from train operation duties, these candidates shall be responsible for setting up of O&M processes pertaining to train operations, work flow and training & learning activities.</u>

After completion of training in Japan, in order to gain further experience of driving High Speed Trains, candidates may be posted in Japan or India, on a secondment basis, with suitable High Speed / Semi High Speed Train Operators, for a period of 1 2 years depending on requirements of the Company.
- 15. <u>Surety Bond</u>: . The candidates selected for the above post will have to execute a surety bond for an amount of **Rs. 5,00,000/-** to serve the corporation for a minimum period of five (5) years (exclusive of the period in which one remained on LWP or EOL) and also a prior notice of 90 days, will be required before seeking resignation from the Corporation.
